Siemens earns Platinum and highest-ever score in EcoVadis Sustainability Rating

- **Siemens exceeds its own best performance with 86¹ points**
- **Rated among the top one percent of around 130,000 companies worldwide**

Siemens has been awarded the Platinum medal – the highest possible distinction – in the 2025 EcoVadis Sustainability Rating. This achievement places Siemens among the top one percent of around 130,000 companies assessed worldwide by EcoVadis, a provider of business sustainability ratings.

The Platinum medal underscores Siemens' unwavering commitment to sustainability and reflects significant achievements across all of EcoVadis' assessment areas: Environment, Ethics, Labor & Human Rights, and Sustainable Procurement. EcoVadis assessed Siemens with a score of 86 points. In addition, Siemens Mobility was assessed separately, achieving a score of 84 points.

More than 90 percent of Siemens' business enables customers to achieve a positive sustainability impact across three key areas: decarbonization and energy efficiency, resource efficiency and circularity, and people centricity & society.

"Achieving the highest-ever score and being among the top one percent of all rated companies reinforces our position as a sustainability leader and recognizes the dedication of our people," says Eva Riesenhuber, Global Head of Sustainability at Siemens. "Sustainability is at the core of our business, and we are continuing to scale our impact in the areas of industry, infrastructure and mobility, while
